

#### AIRLIE SCOTT -PRODUCER

Airlie has a track record as a producer having co-produced and performed with CabarAct Productions- "My Julie!" and the sellout "Venus, Mars & Chocolate Cake" Edinburgh and London Fringe, as well as co-producer for "Wonderful Day' a musical cabaret about the life and music of Doris Day, which toured nationally 6 times, from London to Scotland. More recently she co-produced and performed with Funny Story Productions in "Now Here's a Funny Story!".

#### BAND LEADER / PERFORMER

Performing work includes Westend and Broadway credits, plus European, UK, US, and South Africa tours performing in musicals, theatre, and cabaret as well as some TV and film work. Recent work includes Prudy Pingleton in "Hairspray" Symphony of the Seas (RCCL) and Gertrude in "Hamlet" TNT Theatre / Adge Europe. As a jazz singer, she gigs regularly with her two bands The Hot Jazz Vagabonds and Pronto Swing, as well as gigging on the scene, playing jazz clubs, corporate events, restaurants, swing dance events and more. #### ANDY RUIZ PALMA- GUITARIST

Andy Ruiz Palma - Guitarist - an acoustic and electric jazz guitarist playing both lead and rhythm. He leads the gypsy jazz project La Bouche Manouche playing tunes in the Hot Club style with a repertoire based around good swingtime jazz and French cafe music. #### ALAN GIBSON- DOUBLE BASS

Originally from the New Forest, Alan Gibson moved to London to get involved in the music business as a bass guitarist. He later took an interest in the double bass leading to classical study at The Royal College of Music. He has had the good fortune to play double bass alongside some truly inspiring jazz musicians in London including Jim Mullen, Tony Kofi, Dave O'Higgins, Branden Allen, Quentin Collins, Gareth Lockrane, Anita Wardell and many more.

#### PLICE MARY JELASKA- CLARINET/VOCALS

Alice is a London-based clarinettist and vocalist with influences in her clarinet playing from Eastern Europe, Klezmer, Turkish music. Alongside playing for numerous world music & jazz gigs in UK & Europe she has led Gypsy swing band the Kings Cross Hot Club since 2012, performed at many major venues & events - including Southbank, V&A, Alexandra Palace, Secret Garden Party - and recorded various albums.

#### LEIGH HENSON- CORNET

Leigh Henson plays hot cornet in a variety of styles from early jazz to swing. A founder member of the Mardi Gras Jazzband, performing at jazz socials and private events, Leigh can also be found in London clubs and bars playing for swing dancers and lovers of live music.
